



SUNY Cobleskill Summer Camps Offer STEM, Farm-to-Plate, 3D Printing and Design, Sport Experiences

Cobleskill, NY – SUNY Cobleskill is offering five fun and educational camps for elementary through high school students this summer. The camps, ranging from Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math (STEM) experiences to basketball and sport activities kick off June 25 and run through August 3.

Registration for all of the camps will occur online at <http://www.cobleskill.edu/summercamp>, where participants can register for multiple weeks of camp for one total price or register and pay separately per each camp.

Farm-to-Plate Camp – provides a week-long, intensive educational experience that highlights all of the pieces and processes of the modern food system. From hands-on animal and plant science activities to exciting food science, marketing, and culinary arts experiences, campers will learn in the College’s state-of-the-art farm and food facilities. The businesses and processes used to deliver food from the farm to the plate will be explored in depth with a focus on the ways in which food system design touches every part of our lives. The camp is offered to those in grades 2-5, beginning June 25. The cost to attend is \$150.

STEM Camp: Medieval Ages – will utilize science, technology, engineering, and math to explore the Medieval time period. Participants will be engaged in hands-on activities for students from grades 1 through 6. The week-long camp will be offered in two concurrent weeks beginning July 9. The same content will be taught each week. The cost per week to attend is \$175.

Boys Basketball Camp - Due to gym renovation on the SUNY Cobleskill campus, this camp will be held at Cobleskill-Richmondville High School. Instruction and skill development will be run by the SUNY Cobleskill Men’s Basketball coaching staff and team members. This camp is offered to 3rd – 8th grade students and will run from July 9-13. The cost to attend is \$150.

3D Printing and Design Camp – is a week-long experience focused on Computer Aided Design, 3D printing, measurement, and the design process for grades 7 through 10. Campers will learn basic CAD drafting skills, design and print their own original creations, design and print 3D print objects for group projects and challenges, and learn basic circuit and electric building skills. The camp runs from July 30 to August 3. The cost to attend per week is \$225.

Tiger Tails Activity Camp – is a day camp open for children in Kindergarten through sixth grade. The camp will be offered the weeks of July 23 through July 27 and July 30 through August 3. Activities include wiffle ball, soccer, archery, swimming, arts and crafts, and many more! The cost per camper, per week to attend is \$150.
